How to Use Mayerick®

Coopers MAVERICK is intended for off-shears use (within 24 hours of shearing) on all classes of sheep over 6 weeks of age and greater than 10 kg liveweight.

Coopers MAVERICK is applied along the topline in two adjacent bands, either side of the backline, from the poll (bands may overlap along the neck) to the tail of each sheep using the recommended applicator.
