

### VANQUISH® LONG WOOL

## Spray-on lice treatment and blowfly strike preventative for long woolled sheep and unshorn lambs

VANQUISH contains Alpha-Cypermethrin, a member of the synthetic pyrethroid chemical group. It controls synthetic pyrethroid sheep body lice (Bovicola ovis) sensitive to this family of pesticides.

#### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

#### Restraints

DO NOT USE on ewes which are producing or may in the future produce milk that may be used or processed for human consumption.

Contraindication

This product is contraindicated for use in sheep with skin or fleece abnormalities such as those caused by mycotic dermatitis or fleece rot.

#### LIMITATIONS

- Up to 6 weeks are required for this product to kill lice on treated sheep.
- To avoid possible breakdowns, do not treat ewes later than 6 weeks before lambing.
- Live lice on ewes treated within 6 weeks oflambing can infest the lambs born of those ewes.
- Breakdowns are likely to occur when ewes are treated without treating lambs at foot.

#### **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE.
- 2. Calculate months elapsed since shearing of sheep or age of unshorn lambs and set applicator to deliver appropriate dose for longest woolled sheep in the race. Use the appropriate applicator.
- 3. Attach the applicator to back pack or drum and prime ready to use by squeezing trigger until delivery tube and applicator are full.
- 4. VANQUISH Long Wool can be used at the same time as other management practices but it is recommended to be the last treatment before sheep are returned to paddocks.
- Sheep must be carefully inspected for lice immediately before shearing to determine if treatment post shearing is necessary.
- 6. A scourable pink pigment is included in VANQUISH Long Wool for identification of treated sheep.
- 7. After all sheep are treated or at the end of each day's work, disconnect the applicator from back pack or drum and seal the container tightly. Wash applicator in cold water.
- 8. This product will prevent Body Strike only. Strikes present at the time of VANQUISH Long Wool application should be treated separately. Management practices should ensure that other forms of strike (crutch, pizzle poll, etc.) are prevented.
- 9. VANQUISH Long Wool can be applied to wet sheep.
